21st Judicial District Court judge finalists selected ***Governor to appoint new district court judge***

The Twenty-first Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated two candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Honorable Valerie J. Robison, effective September 28, 2024. Nominees JenniLynn E. Lawrence of Mancos and Jennifer Lee Springer of Grand Junction were selected by the commission on August 1, 2024.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from August 2, 2024, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Twenty-first Judicial District (Mesa County).
