Second Judicial District Court Judge Finalist Selected

Governor to appoint two new district court judges

The Second Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated six candidates for two district court judgeships created by the retirements of the Hon. David H. Goldberg and the Hon. Jennifer B. Torrington, both occurring on Jan. 14, 2025. Nominees Angela Denise Boykins of Aurora, and Rachel Anne Catt, Ruchi Kapoor, Heidi L. Kutcher, Jason Bryce Robinson, Jerad A. West, all of Denver, were selected by the commission on August 13, 2024.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from August 14, 2024, to appoint two nominees as district court judges for the Second Judicial District (Denver County).
