Outline of Work Done Towards Completion of Appropriation and Application of Water to Beneficial Use. The Applicants' predecessor in Case No. 00CW124 sought to adjudicate several water rights as part of an integrated system. The Water Court entered a partial decree on April 26, 2005, for a portion of the water rights subject of the application filed in Case No. 00CW124 (the "Partial Ruling"). The Water Court decreed the remaining water rights subject of Case No. 00CW124 on July 26, 2007. The Partial Ruling adjudicated four conditional water rights for stockwatering and storage for irrigation of the Applicants' property. This Application is for a finding of reasonable diligence and to make partially absolute those conditional water rights decreed in the Partial Decree. During this diligence period, Applicants constructed Fuchs Pond No. 12 in August, 2006, and installed a 12" pipeline from Reservoir Ditch Enlargement to fill Fuchs Pond No. 12. Applicants filled Fuchs Pond No. 12 with 13 acre feet of water from Fuchs Pond No. 6 and the Reservoir Ditch and has since used that water for the beneficial uses of stockwatering and irrigation purposes since Spring, 2007. Applicants and their predecessor spent \$12,000.00, for labor, material, and equipment to construct Fuchs Pond No. 12 and an additional \$20,000.00 to construct the pipeline from Reservoir Ditch to Fuchs Pond No. 12. During 2006, applicant also enlarged the Reservoir Ditch by installing a 24" flume and a 24" plastic corrugated pipe. Upon completion, Applicant diverted 10 c.f.s. of the Reservoir Ditch Enlargement for stockwatering purpose and for storage in Fuchs Pond No. 12 for the irrigation of 185 acres on April 30, 2007. Applicants and their predecessor spent \$31,000.00 for labor material, and equipment to enlarge the Reservoir Ditch. Applicant also installed a new headgate at the diversion point for the Aragon Ditch for future diversions of the Aragon Ditch Enlargement. Additionally, Applicants have staked out the location for Fuchs Pond No. 6 Enlargement for future enlargement. During this diligence period, Applicants and their predecessor have spent over \$63,000.00 on the direct development of the conditional water rights and their application to beneficial use. Applicant has, therefore, devoted substantial efforts toward the development of their water rights, the present and further application of water from Fuchs Pond No. 6 Enlargement, Fuchs Pond No. 12, Reservoir Ditch Enlargement, and the Aragon Ditch Enlargement to beneficial use.
