

In the criminal complaint the People filed multiple legal theories for many of the attempted murder victims. The People have conducted a detailed examination of the evidence during the trial preparation process. The People give notice to the Court and Defendant the People are electing NOT to proceed on the counts below. Below each substantive count the People have identified the corresponding sentence enhancer count as it will no longer be applicable.

COUNT 11-CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE (F2)

On or about March 22, 2021, by engaging in conduct constituting a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree, Ahmad Al Aliwi Alissa unlawfully, feloniously, after deliberation, and with the intent to cause the death of a person other than himself attempted to cause the death of Angela Peacock; in violation of sections 18-3-102(1)(a) and 18-2-101, C.R.S.

AND CORRESPONDING COUNT 69

COUNT 15-CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE (F2)

On or about March 22, 2021, by engaging in conduct constituting a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree, Ahmad Al Aliwi Alissa unlawfully, feloniously, after deliberation, and with the intent to cause the death of a person other than himself attempted to cause the death of Khagendra Malla; in violation of sections 18-3-102(1)(a) and 18-2-101, C.R.S.

COUNT 17-CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE (F2)

On or about March 22, 2021, by engaging in conduct constituting a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree, Ahmad Al Aliwi Alissa unlawfully, feloniously, after deliberation, and with the intent to cause the death of a person other than himself attempted to cause the death of Jacqueline Keeton; in violation of sections 18-3-102(1)(a) and 18-2-101, C.R.S.

CORRESPONDING COUNT 75

COUNT 19-CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE (F2)

On or about March 22, 2021, by engaging in conduct constituting a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree, Ahmad Al Aliwi Alissa unlawfully, feloniously, after deliberation, and with the intent to cause the death of a person other than himself attempted to cause the death of Paul Johnson; in violation of sections 18-3-102(1)(a) and 18-2-101, C.R.S.

CORRESPONDING COUNT 77

COUNT 21-CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE (F2)

On or about March 22, 2021, by engaging in conduct constituting a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree, Ahmad Al Aliwi Alissa unlawfully, feloniously, after deliberation, and with the intent to cause the death of a person other than himself attempted to cause the death of Kymberly Brekhus; in violation of sections 18-3-102(1)(a) and 18-2-101, C.R.S.

CORRESPONDING COUNT 79

COUNT 23-CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE (F2)

On or about March 22, 2021, by engaging in conduct constituting a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree, Ahmad Al Aliwi Alissa unlawfully, feloniously, after deliberation, and with the intent to cause the death of a person other than himself attempted to cause the death of Mykah Huang; in violation of sections 18-3-102(1)(a) and 18-2-101, C.R.S.

CORRESPONDING COUNT 81

COUNT 25-CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE (F2)

On or about March 22, 2021, by engaging in conduct constituting a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree, Ahmad Al Aliwi Alissa unlawfully, feloniously, after deliberation, and with the intent to cause the death of a person other than himself attempted to cause the death of Tasia Beresford; in violation of sections 18-3-102(1)(a) and 18-2-101, C.R.S.

CORRESPONDING COUNT 83

COUNT 27-CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE (F2)

On or about March 22, 2021, by engaging in conduct constituting a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree, Ahmad Al Aliwi Alissa unlawfully, feloniously, after deliberation, and with the intent to cause the death of a person other than himself attempted to cause the death of Patrick Kruse; in violation of sections 18-3-102(1)(a) and 18-2-101, C.R.S.

CORRESPONDING COUNT 85

COUNT 29-CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO COMMIT MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE (F2)

On or about March 22, 2021, by engaging in conduct constituting a substantial step toward the commission of murder in the first degree, Ahmad Al Aliwi Alissa unlawfully, feloniously, after deliberation, and with the intent to cause the death of a person other than himself attempted to cause the death of James Graham; in violation of sections 18-3-102(1)(a) and 18-2-101, C.R.S.

CORRESPONDING COUNT 87

The Court has previously dismissed Counts 65-68.
