Dolores County Court Judge Finalist Selected Governor to appoint new county court judge

The Twenty-second Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated one candidate for a county court judgeship created by the appointment of the Honorable Ian J. MacLaren to the Montezuma County Court bench, which occurs on Nov. 18, 2024. Nominee Kristen Mary McLaughlin Tarrin of Edwards was selected by the commission on Nov. 13, 2024

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Nov. 14, 2024, to appoint one of the nominees as within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Dolores County.
