11th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new district court judge

The Eleventh Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a Fremont district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Patrick W. Murphy, effective Jan. 1, 2025. The commission selected nominees Colleen R. Lamb of Bailey, Daniel B. Slater of Florence, and Lauren Tai Swan of Cañon City on Dec. 3, 2024.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Dec. 4, 2024, to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Eleventh Judicial District (Chaffee, Custer, Fremont and Park counties).
