17th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new district court judge

The Seventeenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship, effective on Dec. 31, 2024, created by the death of the Hon. Sharon Holbrook. Nominees Stephanie R. Perkins of Brighton, Sara S. Price of Denver, and Toni J. Wehman of Westminster were selected by the commission on Jan. 24, 2025.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from today within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Seventeenth Judicial District (Adams and Broomfield Counties).
