Duration

6+ Months

#### Step 0 Decide & Prepare

Order and Pay for Transcripts (<u>IDF 4</u>). File in: DC.

Optional Preparations

File a Motion to Waive Fees (<u>JDF 205</u> and <u>206</u>). File in: DC.

#### Step 1 Give Notice

Form: Notice of Appeal (<u>IDF 1911</u>). File in: CoA and DC.

Within 49 days of: Due:

- 1. Final Order (from Judge or Magistrate), or
- 2. Order denying a timely Motion for Post-Trial Relief.

#### Step 2 **Designate Transcripts**

Form: Designation of Tran. (<u>IDF 1912</u>). File in: CoA and DC.

Within 7 Days of Step 1. Due:

#### Step 3 Record on Appeal

Sent by the DC within 63 days of Step 1.

Not sent if: Transcripts or Cost Bond not paid.

#### Steps 4-6 Written Arguments

Your arguments over the issues.

File in: CoA

- 4 Opening Brief (IDF 1915). By Aplt. Due: 42 Days of Step 3.
- **5** Answer Brief (<u>IDF 1916</u>). By Aple. Due: 35 Days of Step 4.
- **6** Reply Brief (<u>IDF 1917</u>). By Aplt. Due: 21 Days of Step 5.

#### Step 7 **Opinion**

Written decision issued by a 3 Judge panel.

Sent about 3-4 months after the case is assigned to a division.

## **Quick Facts**

- 1. Not a New Trial: you will not be allowed to present new evidence or call witnesses on appeal.
- **2.** An Appeal is a review of the Judge's decisions in your case. Not the conduct of opposing attorneys or witnesses.
- 3. Issues: the alleged mistakes the DC made in managing or deciding the case.
- 4. The CoA will look at the issues to see if there were any errors in the law, or to see if the court's findings were clearly wrong, or if the court abused their discretion.
- **5. Roles:** The appellant (Aplt) is the person who brings the appeal, the appellee (Aple) is the person who responds to the appeal.
