2nd Judicial District Court judge finalists selected ***Governor to appoint new district court judge***

The Second Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the resignation of the Hon. Darryl F. Shockley, effective February 1, 2025.

Nominees Ian J. Kellogg of Denver, Jason Bryce Robinson of Denver, and Jerad A. West of Denver were selected by the commission on February 4, 2025.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from today, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Second Judicial District (Denver County).
