### **18th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected** ***Governor to appoint new county court judge***

The Eighteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a county court judgeship, effective on Feb. 28, 2025, created by the appointment of Hon. Joshua J. Williford to the Arapahoe County District Court bench. Nominees Jessica A. Brazil of Englewood, Robert E. Caldwell, Jr. of Centennial, and Garen D. Gervy of Littleton were selected by the commission on Feb. 28, 2025, via Webex video conferencing.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from February 28 within which to appoint one of the nominees as a county court judge for the Eighteenth Judicial District (Arapahoe County).
