ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING COURT OPERATIONS POST PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY LEAVE

In light of the Public Health Emergency Leave (PHEL) ending June 8, 2023, as well as the COVID-19 ("novel coronavirus") pandemic determined to be over by actions of the State of Colorado as well as the CDC, the Court hereby vacates all prior Administrative Orders addressing COVID-19.

However, based on lessons learned from the pandemic, as well as relying on recommendations regarding the spread of communicable diseases generally, the Court, pursuant to the authority granted in Chief Justice Directive 95-01 hereby ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Persons experiencing symptoms related to illness, specifically persons experiencing fever, (100 degrees Fahrenheit or 38 degrees Celsius or higher), diarrhea, or vomiting are prohibited from entering any 19th Judicial Court building or space until free from such symptoms at least 24 hours after they are free of fever without the use of fever-reducing medicines or other symptom relieving medications.
- 2. Prior to coming to court, the jury, attorneys and their staff, parties, witnesses, and court personnel shall self-screen to determine whether they have symptoms and shall inform the court if anyone is experiencing symptoms.
- 3. All prior orders regarding COVID-19 restrictions are hereby vacated.
- 4. The method of appearances before the Court remains at the discretion of the presiding judicial officer.

The Court finds this order is necessary to protect persons using the court facilities, whether employees, parties, attorneys or others. I reserve the right to modify, revise, or vacate this order at any time to meet the health and safety needs of the public.
