17th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new district court judge

The 17th Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship, effective on June 7, 2025, created by the retirement of the Hon. Rayna Gokli. Nominees Todd Everet Bluth of Brighton, Michal Anne Lord-Blegen of Denver, and Stephanie Rachel Perkins of Brighton were selected by the commission on April 21, 2025.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from today within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the 17th Judicial District (Adams and Broomfield Counties).
