ORDER AUTHORIZING PERSONS TO DISMISS COUNTS IN CASE RECORD WHERE NO CHARGE DISPOSITION EXISTS



## CHIEF JUDGE ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2023-01

Pursuant to the authority granted to chief judges of the judicial districts of the State of Colorado by Chief Justice Directive 95-01, the undersigned, as Chief Judge of the Twelfth Judicial District of Colorado, allows authorized persons to dismiss counts in the Court's case management system of record where no charge disposition exists for Criminal, Traffic, Misdemeanor, Felony, Juvenile, or Juvenile Delinquency cases prior to and including the current calendar year.

Authorized persons include the Clerk of Court for the county court, the Clerk of Court for the district court, and any court judicial assistants delegated the responsibility by the Clerk of Court. This authorization will apply only upon final disposition of a case to assist with the administrative closeout of the record.

In such cases where this Order is applicable, the authorized persons shall enter a minute order in the case management system referencing CJAO 2023-01, dismiss outstanding counts where no prior charge disposition exists, and update the charge information accordingly.
